

NCURATV Web Polling Instructions

Thank you for participating in the live web polling feature of NCURATV 2007. Below are the instructions for testing the webex polling software on the computer you will be using on show day:

Please note the use of a computer is only necessary for the webex polling. You will not be able to view the broadcast over the internet. Also, you may only use one computer per institution to participate in the webex polling.

1. Testing Your Computer Equipment & Downloading the Necessary Software (please do this before show day):

- Do this on the computer that you will be using the day of the program.
- Please go to: **<http://www.krm.com/webextest>**
- Please click on "test your computer now"
- Follow the on-screen instructions
- Once you receive the "successfully completed" message, please close your browser. (This process may take a few minutes depending upon your connection speed.)

2. Joining the web polling on broadcast day (please do this 10 minutes before the program on 9/11/07 - 11:20 am EDT):

Close all of the applications that may be running on your computer (except outlook), open your browser, go to this URL: <http://krm1.webex.com> (No WWW.)

- A list of events will appear. Find the date: **September 11, 2007**, then click on **Event 12971**
- Click on the JOIN button for your event. (The JOIN button will become active 15 minutes prior to the program start time. You may need to refresh your browser to see the JOIN button.)
- Enter your First name, Last name, email address and the event password: 12971 (The way you type your name in as you join will be the way that your name is displayed during the program.)
- Click on JOIN
